Project description

Asbri Transport was appointed by Jehu Project Services in 2011 to support a planning application to construct a 2,000sq.m commercial office development (employing up to 450 staff) at Baglan Energy Park Port Talbot.

Asbri Transport produced a Travel Plan which sets out how employee travel will be monitored and a number of measures to encourage and promote the use of more sustainable modes. As part of the process, we reviewed the accessibility of the site by a range of transport modes, including walking, cycling and public transport, as well as by car. This included a detailed investigation of the appropriate level of on-site parking.

Using the local Travel to Work statistics from the 2001 Census as the basis for the Travel Plan targets, we have developed a range of measures to encourage staff to use more sustainable modes of transport to travel to/from work and for work purposes. These include a range of measures with a particular focus on communicating travel information, financial incentives and subsidising bus services
